How to create and use Private channels

CBTalk V2.0 gives users with DualMikes hardware to create one private Group (Channel). The creator of the channel is the only Admin who can remove (ban) users and temporary or definitively close the Private group channel. Midland and Midland regional Admins are not responsible on private channel and the enforce of Midland T&C rules can not be guaranteed on these Private groups channels. However, Midland always has the right to Mute or Delete the Private channel when any activity against the community or against the law is detected by the competent authorities.

Two Channel type are available: Private "close" or Private "open".

Private close Group

This is a "close" channel that is visible only to the users that are invited from the Creator (Admin).

When the Group is created, you will need to also choose, from your Address book list of CBTalk, all the users that will see your channel. The Private close group name will be AUTOMATICALLY added on the top of the Group list window only to the user that are "invited" by the creator.

Midland Admins can not enter this channels and can not ban any user.

Only the creator is responsible of the channel.

Private open Group

This is an "open" channel that is visible to any users.

The Private open group name can be added on the top of the main App Group list window only if the user choose it in the "Add Group list".

Midland Admins can enter this channels as any other user but is not responsible of the channel.

Only the creator is responsible of the channel.



In the **main App Group list**, a small horizontal line will divide the Private channel on the top from the standard Midland channels on the bottom


All the current open channel from Midland are still available and are still managed by Midland Admins, the Terms and Conditions of use for those channels are still the same as today.






How to see private channel

Go to the main menu and choose "Add Groups"



You will enter the screen with the list of all the already existing Private Group channel available in the region (nation) you have in your selection. This window can be empty if no Private Group are available in your region.

Every Private group show the name of the channel, the ID and Name of the creator (Admin). If the Admin name is not visible under the Group name, it means the Private channel was created using the option "Admin not Visible". On the right side of the Group name, you have the number of users that are active in the Private Group.



In case you alrady know the name of the Group you can also use the "Lens" icon to search for a specific Private group.

How to add an existing Private channel to your main Group list

In this window you can choose which private group you want to add in your main App group list. Just click on the small square box on the right of the group name to add it.





Create a Private channel

In order to create a Private channel you must own a DualMike.

The DualMike does not need to be connect (or powered on) when you create the Private Group.

If you want to create your own Private channel, you need to click on the small icon in the up right corner. The Create Group window will show up. You can only create one Private group.



Just give a name to the Group and choose if it is **Public** or **Private**.

If you choose Private, you also need to click on "Add User" and choose, from your Address book of CBTalk, the name of all the users that are allow to enter the channel.

You have 3 option:

Map Zoom Unlocked

If you check this option, all the users in the channel have the map with full zoom possibility

Mute Group

If you check this option, the channel is muted and nobody can talk anymore (the channel is still visible but the PTT button is disabled)

Admin not Visible

If you check this option, the name of the Admin (creator) of the group will not be visible under the Group name. In addition the Admin will be a normal user (no shield icon and no PTT over in red color), but they still have the ability to ban the users from the Private Group channel.

When finish remember to click on "Save" button

<u>Attention</u>: If you want to change the already existing channel type from Public to Private (or vice versa), you need to delete the Private group and start over.

How to ban a user

The creator (Admin) of the Private Group channel, can ban a user 24hr or Permanent. Just select the user, click on "Admin" button and choose the type of ban you need.





The ban is active only in your own Private Group (where you are Admin), if the user move to a different Group he will be able to talk as usual.
